



PARENTAL CONSENT FORM FOR CANDIDATES UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE

Teastas Eorpach na Gaeilge

The Teastas Eorpach na Gaeilge examinations are tests for adult learners of Irish. A number of secondary schools offer their students these tests also and they are held in the relevant school building. However, a small number of candidates of schoolgoing age, possibly under eighteen years of age, who are not registered by their school, may elect to take the tests outside a school setting, where the majority of candidates are over eighteen years of age. In this case, candidates will take writing, reading and listening test in a hall with adult candidates in the presence of two invigilators. The speaking test, which will be recorded, will be taken individually in the presence of two examiners.

I confirm that I have read and understand the information above and that I consent to my child taking the tests in the conditions described above.

I understand that my child will be taking writing, reading and listening tests in Irish in a setting where most of the candidates are over eighteen years of age.

I understand that the speaking test will be administered by two examiners and will be recorded. I understand that all data pertaining to my child will be treated confidentially.
